



# COVID-19 Guidelines

Students will be sent home to isolate/test if the following conditions exist:

## TWO OF THE FOLLOWING:

Fever  
Chills  
Rigors  
Body/Muscle Aches  
Headache  
Sore Throat  
Nausea or Vomiting  
Diarrhea  
Fatigue  
Congestion/Runny Nose

OR

**(persons who have a fever, vomiting, or diarrhea should not attend in person)**

## ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

Cough

Shortness of Breath

Difficulty Breathing

Loss of Taste

Loss of Smell

## COVID-19 Return to School Guidelines (2021-2022) (Updated 1/11/22)

### *Positive COVID Test*

May Return 5 days after symptom onset

OR

5 days after test date if no symptoms

AND

No fever for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications

AND

No symptoms listed above

(Those with moderate symptoms or severely ill follow a 10 day isolation)

### *Symptoms – Negative COVID Test*

May return when fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications

AND

No symptoms listed above

### *COVID Exposure – Close Contact*

May Return after 5 days of last contact

AND

No fever for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications

AND

No symptoms listed above

(Fully vaccinated asymptomatic close contacts do not need to quarantine)

If you did not receive your booster you are not considered fully vaccinated)

### *Symptoms – No COVID Test*

May Return 5 days after symptom onset

AND

May return when fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications

AND

No symptoms listed above
