



COVID-19 Guidelines

Students will be sent home to isolate/test if the following conditions exist:

TWO OF THE FOLLOWING:

Fever
Chills
Rigors
Body/Muscle Aches
Headache
Sore Throat
Nausea or Vomiting
Diarrhea
Fatigue
Congestion/Runny Nose

OR

(persons who have a fever, vomiting, or diarrhea should not attend in person)

ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

Cough
Shortness of Breath
Difficulty Breathing
Loss of Taste
Loss of Smell

COVID-19 Return to School Guidelines (2022-2023) (Updated 9/13/22)

Positive COVID Test

May Return 5 days after symptom onset
OR
5 days after test date if no symptoms
AND
No fever for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications
AND
No symptoms listed above
(Those with moderate symptoms or severely ill follow a 10 day isolation)

Symptoms – Negative COVID Test

May return when fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications
AND
No symptoms listed above

COVID Exposure – Close Contact

May Return after 5 days of last contact
AND
No fever for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications
AND
No symptoms listed above
(Fully vaccinated asymptomatic close contacts do not need to quarantine
If you did not receive your booster you are not considered fully vaccinated)

Symptoms – No COVID Test

May Return 5 days after symptom onset
AND
May return when fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications
AND
No symptoms listed above
