

## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER**

### **Monitoring and Reporting Requirements Not Met for Long Pond School Water System – PWSID NJ1902304**

We are required to report monitoring results of your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water meets health standards. During monitoring period for the Fourth Quarter of 2021 for your water system we failed to monitor and report the routine total coliform required by the state.

Our system failed to notify the state drinking water program as required by the State of NJ within 24 hours. Although public health was not impacted, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct the situation.

#### **What should I do?**

There is nothing you need to do at this time. You do not need to boil your water or take other actions.

#### **What is being done?**

While we did not notify the state as quickly as we should have, we have taken measures to make sure this does not happen in the future.
